Update on 45 (Pres) disbursement on ICE re: immigrants

- So far, no increase in enforcement
- ICE is in town every week, if people have and removal ordered they are here.
- Immigration informant response team. This team meets weekly – Fabiola Coord (608.242-6260) first point of contact, Centro Hispano. FB and LIVE is official communication. MMSD, MPD, Mayor office, Shiva, Attorneys, Centro Hispano. Activate
- Black or white large SUV marked Homeland security. Target Cambodia, African French speaking and Latinx community is highest number.
- There is a ER response booklet posted on Dane Co and MMSD website
- Those tweets engaged trauma, need to educate, our community they are only looking at part of the people.
- You don't have to open your door if they don't have a warrant, identify themselves. To let them inside their house.
