5. New Business:
 - a. Padres e Hijos En Accion Presentation – Hector Portillo
 - i. Grassroots organization, works with individuals with disabilities, their families, friends and community members building fulfilling and community centered lives for LatinX
 - ii. Do a lot of activities like cooking, gardening, cycling, jumping at trampoline par, soccer, art, etc. to help kids improve motor and social skills
 - iii. Provide medial/insurance/equipment/supplies to families who don't qualify for other assistance
 - b. Rape Crisis Center Presentation – Marcela Kyngesburye
 - i. 1 in 4 girls and 1 and 6 boys are sexually assaulted before the age of 18
 - ii. Advocates for those harmed by sexual violence by centering survivors, promoting societal change, and committing to be an evolving force of change
 - iii. Trying to prevent normalization of rape jokes, cat calling, etc. to promote social change
 - iv. Have 24/7 help lines, advocacy and emotional support services, includes outreach and education
